LIFT HOURS OF OPERATION

Frontside Lifts: 1, 2, 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, 13
Open 9am – 4pm

Backside Lifts: 3, 5, 8
Open 9am – 3:30pm (lift 5 hours vary)

Lift operations may change throughout the season. Check daily snow report for updated information on open lifts and hours of operation.

TRAIL HOURS OF OPERATION

The following trails may have modified hours:

McCormack's Maze closes at 2pm daily.

Lower Wapiti & Lower Bull Run closes at 2pm when Lift 5 Grizzly Lift is not operating.
